After an auto accident a few years ago, we needed to do an extensive remodel to our house to make it wheelchair accessible. Dave Schertzing built the original house we live in and has always been very receptive to help us fix any issues, so we asked him to do the remodel work.

Dave worked with our insurance company and the physical therapists to draw out a plan including making the first floor barrier free, adjusting counter tops to an appropriate work surface height, changing the flooring on the ground level, modifying kitchen cabinets to include pull-out shelves, a complete remodel of the bathroom, and enlarging the garage to accommodate a wheelchair ramp. He took into consideration all of the recommendations laid out by my therapists and made an appropriate design. Dave was very sensitive to our situation and worked within a very tight deadline in order to let us return home quickly without compromising quality.

At the time of the accident, the first floor was filled with furniture. Dave took care of moving the furniture to the second floor and covered up any remaining furniture so that it wouldn't get damaged.
